

Installation Guidelines

Random Plank

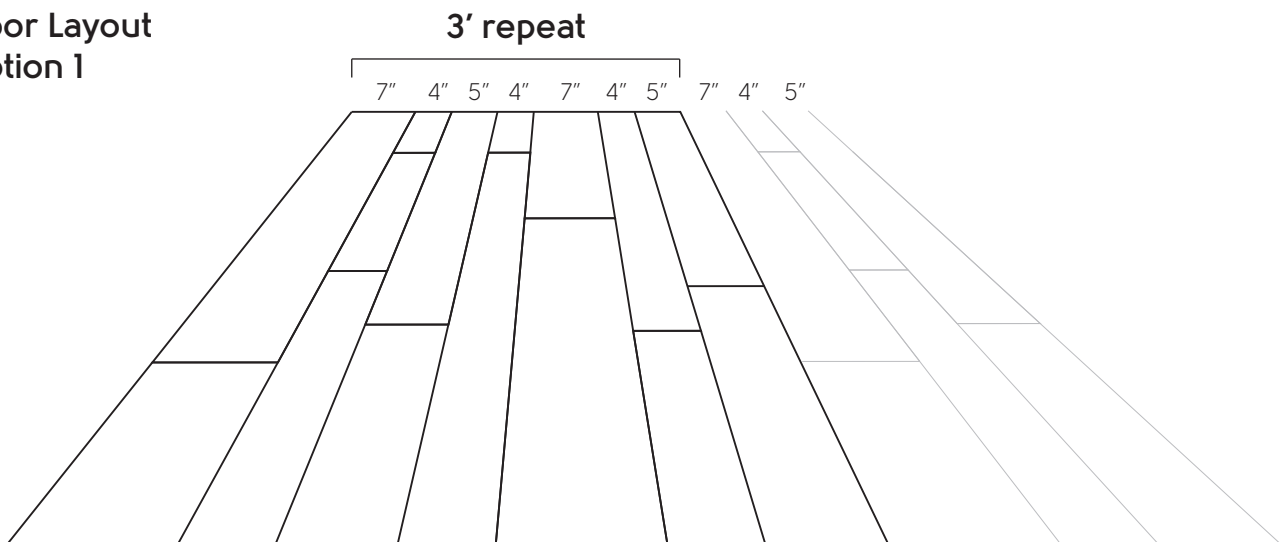


Each box of 24 sq.ft. (2.23 m²) contains 22 planks in the following quantities:

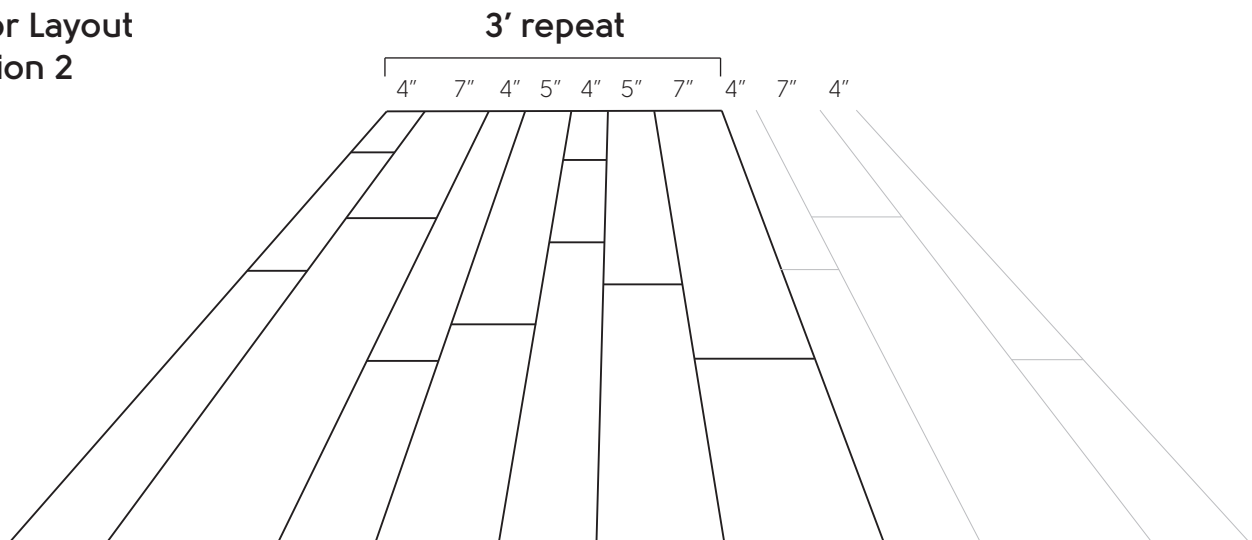
| 7" (178 mm) wide | 5" (127 mm) wide | 4" (102 mm) wide |
|------------------|------------------|------------------|
| 48" (1219 mm) x2 | 48" (1219 mm) x2 | 48" (1219 mm) x2 |
| 30" (762 mm) x2 | 28" (711 mm) x2 | 32" (812 mm) x2 |

The ratio of 7" to 5" to 4" planks is 2:2:3, meaning that when installing the product you should fit 2 rows of 7" and 5" planks to 3 rows of 4" planks, irrespective of the length of the plank run. This 3' pattern can then be repeated across the room. We recommend you install one box at a time to ensure the 2:2:3 ratio is followed.

Floor Layout Option 1



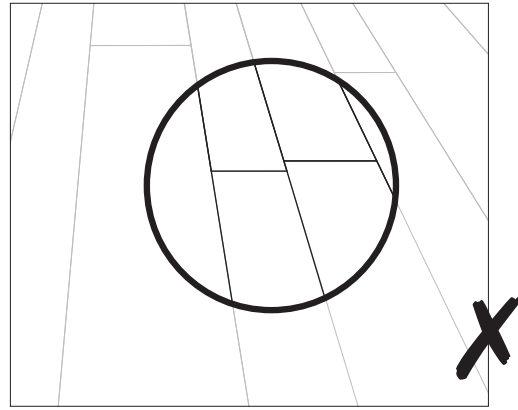
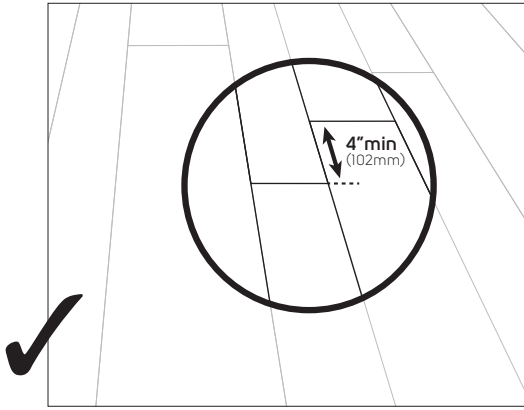
Floor Layout Option 2

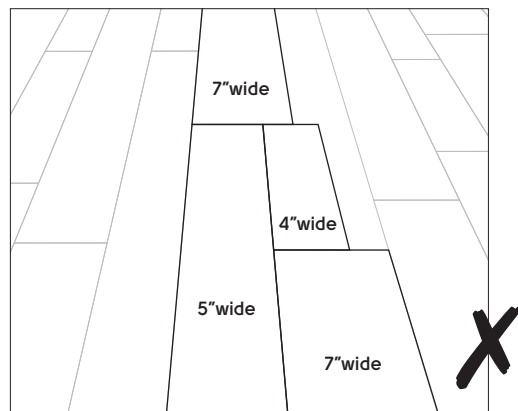
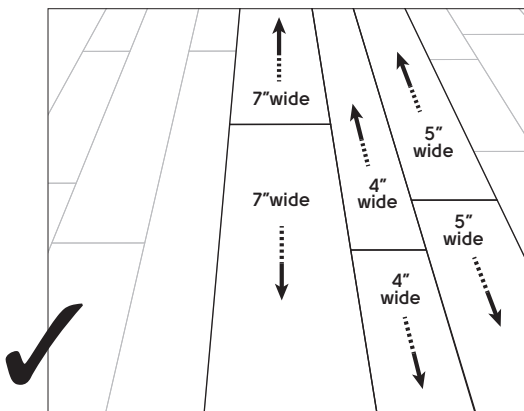
Tip 1

Joins should be a minimum of 4" (102 mm) apart.



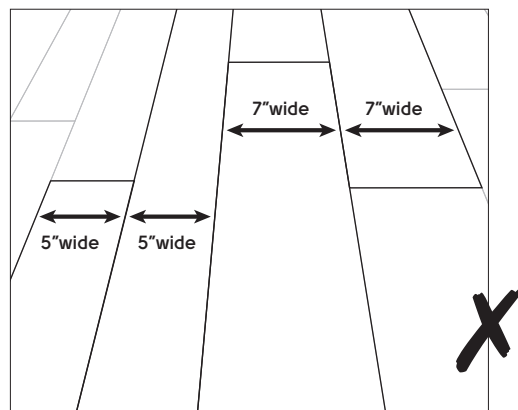
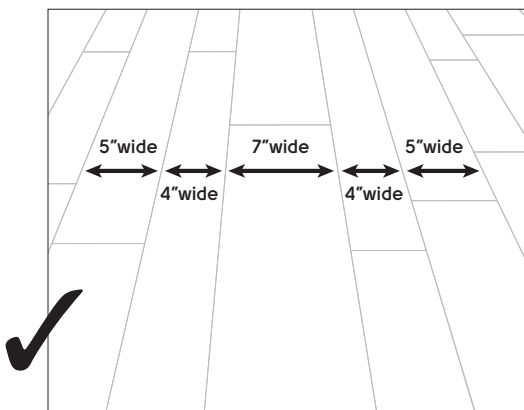
Tip 2

Once a width is started, continue this along the length of the room.



Tip 3

Always lay different planks widths next to each other.



Tip 4

To achieve a truly random effect, do not fit all short lengths together. This could lead to fitting issues at the end of the installation.
