Design your space



HERRINGBONE STONE

For this space we chose to lay the floor in a herringbone pattern. As you can see, the tiles are pointing both into the kitchen and towards the living room. This helps to draw guests into the room in both potential directions of travel.

BORDER


Knowing that we are not updating the adjoining rooms or hallways, and wanting to create separation from the kitchen to the living area, we added a border to frame the room. A plank border helps to zone each area and frame the newly renovated room.

PLANKS ON A 45°


We chose to the lay the planks on a 45 degree angle as we knew people would be travelling into the living room, both from the kitchen and the back door. No matter your entry point, you are still being drawn into the room.

Hickory


As a slow-growing wood, natural hickory takes at least 40 years to mature and can live up to 300 years. Our hickory designs expose a beauty only visible with age, developed from boards recovered from a midwest lumber yard. These logs were milled using a wide circular saw blade, which inspired the emboss we created to give the planks a genuine, subtle, cross-sawn appearance and texture.


BEHIND THE DESIGN Driftwood

This design mimics the gentle, sea-worn features of reclaimed driftwood. Inspired by driftwood found on Fraser Island in Australia, the aged wood was roughly sanded and cross sawn, giving the final product the rustic look the designers were going for. Saltwater combined with high winds drains the natural tannins and nutrients from the wood before it ends up on shore. We have been able to capture this unique character of the driftwood in our Coastal Driftwood and Beach Driftwood planks.






Redwood

The tie was made of American Redwood, the tallest living trees on earth, which are found in California along the Pacific Ocean. Known for their impressive resistance to decay — hence their use as railroad ties and trestles — many of the old ties have been repurposed and reused as steps, house beams and furniture.


Sourced from quarries located in the heart of England's famous Lake District, these designs were created from formed volcanic rock dating back 300 million years. Only once a year, dynamite is used to extract slabs, which are then manually removed from the quarries. Two designs were created: one, a ground and polished design with an even finish; the other, exposing the natural split in the layers of the slate.

Combine different design strip colours to tie in other elements of your home to your flooring, like your countertop or furniture. CER17 **Drift** Inspired by the classic structure and timeless appeal of limestone, Drift reproduces the grain and fossilisation of the natural stone in a far darker palette. The wide bevels of Da Vinci emphasise the rectangular shape of these tiles as the light falls across them. Design strips can be added to introduce a more traditional tile look, as seen here.






